The photo below is from our journey on the road from Juba to Yei in southern Sudan in September. This was one of five serious mud pits we had to traverse. The minor flooded areas were too numerous to count. We made it through them all. Nothing will stop us from following the Lord’s call...and so back we go tomorrow!

We travel first to Gulu in northern Uganda to prepare for the December medical mission. We will build relationships by doing health teachings in two IDP camps near Gulu. The first weekend in December, we return with the first all African medical mission team.

After Gulu, we travel on to Nimule in southern Sudan. We are returning to do more medical work and a little theology. Three southern Sudanese health

care workers who are potential “Timothys” will be on site as well.
